One-week TEQIP-III sponsored online Student Development Programme on title “Students’ Learning & Skill Enhancement through Interdisciplinary Interventions” was conducted for the students of different branches like Computer Science and Engineering, Information Technology, MBA, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering etc. This Programme was organized by the Department of Information Technology and Computer Science & Engineering, Guru Nanak Dev Engineering College (GNDEC), Ludhiana during 1st – 6th March 2021. TEQIP-III enables the students to introspect & learn latest techniques that can help them to contribute for the betterment of themselves & society through knowledge enhancement.

Dr. Parminder Singh (Head) Dept. of Computer Science & Engineering gave the overview about the program. 
Then in the later session Sir gave some precious knowledge about Funds Management in Banking systems, how can they earn more money from money without doing anything but just only with some presence of mind.



Overall as per the feedback from the participants, it was an excellent learning experience in which they gathered a lot of knowledge and skills.




