


ANNEXURE E - ACTIVITY REPORT

This report is the summary of Two-week online training programme organised by the Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering for the students to impart training on Future Skill technologies. Under the NPIU program, "Train-the-Trainer", job-oriented training programme titled "Skill Development Workshop on Information Security" was successfully organised from 8 Feb., 2021 to 20 Feb., 2021.

Students of third year of department of ECE, CSE, and IT have attended this training programme. About 40 students from mentioned departments have registered and 24 hours of theory and practical sessions were conducted over the period of course. The key topics for discussion include fundamentals of Cryptology, classical and modern cryptographic protocols used in the domain of Information Security. Apart from discussion of theoretical concepts, hands-on-training sessions were also conducted to comprehend the prominent areas of the field. To evaluate the performance of students, a test was conducted at the end of every week. On the basis of attendance and performance, eligible students will get the certificate of participation.

After attending this course, students would be able to comprehend, work and contribute in the field of cyber security. Apart from the regular curriculum which students studied during their course, such training programme will help them for bridging and interpreting the trends of Information Security with the modern technology being used nowadays.
